**Submission Form for Photograph Review**

As part of the accreditation process, Special Kids Photography of America requests submission of four (4) photographs of children with disability or serious illness that have been authored by the applicant. Listed here are criteria for acceptance of your photographs by SKPA. Please refer to the pictorial examples provided in the SKPA "Photo Standards" sample sheet.

1. Submit your best competition quality work. If the photo "is all you have" and you're not sure if it will pass, don't submit it). Wait till you are certain you have a quality, professional product.
2. If you are unsure of the quality of your work, approach a PPA Certified photographer for advice.
3. Studio or location candids of acceptable quality are allowed but "snapshots" will not meet the criteria.
4. Is the photograph saleable to the parent?
5. Photos will be reviewed for: lighting, appropriate clothing, composition, surrounding "clutter," sharpness, etc.
6. Does the photo show the child "enjoying a moment of life?"
7. Photograph may include parent, sibling, animals or friends.
8. If we ask you to "try again" to replace one or more of your photographs, do not get discouraged. Learn what it takes to improve your work and keep trying until you achieve success!

**Review and Evaluation Process** Photographic submissions will be juried to determine acceptability. Please allow at least 4 weeks for notification. If a photograph is rejected, a critique is provided to help you improve the quality of your work for future subsequent submissions.

**Your submission packet must include:** 1) Signed copy of this form, 2) 4 - 8x10 UNMOUNTED prints of your own work, 3) CD with images + completed digital version of this form, 4) 3 referral letters about your and your work from parents 5) a SKPA photo release or own for each image. Digital images must be 8x10 @ 300 res with the following information in the caption: your last name + image number + disorder (ex: smith 02autism.jpg)
